


Wisteria - a triangular crocheted scarf

A soft and light triangular scarf. The narrow ends makes it easy to tie in many different ways. The design makes it easy to crochet and it can be made in any size. The pattern uses UK terminology.

Materials

100 (250) g Merici from Filcolana
Crochet hook 5 mm

The shown versions

Peach (small size): color 1130
Greyish blue (large size): color 1061

Size

The scarf is shown in two different sizes. It is easy to make the scarf in any size you wish. The numbers in parentheses is for the large size.

Finished measurements

Length: 165 (240) cm
Height: 35 (55) cm

Gauge

24 rows in pattern = 10 cm

Abbreviations

ch (chain)
dc (double crochet)
tr (treble)



Notes

The scarf is made bottom-up, and increases are made at both sides. The arrow in the chart shows the crochet direction. The pattern uses double crochets and chains. In the edge trebles are used instead of double crochets to give a nice and flexible edge. When the size of the scarf suits you liking, you fasten off.

Scarf

Ch 4.

1. row: 2 tr in the 3rd ch from the hook, ch 1, 3 tr in next ch (1 chain arch).

Vend med 2 lm.

2. row: 2 tr in first tr, ch 2, 2 dc in ch-arch, ch 2. 3 tr in the last tr (2 chain arches). Turn and ch 2.

3. row: 2 tr in first tr, ch 2, *2 dc in ch-arch, ch 2*. Repeat from * to * to end. 3 tr in last tr (3 chain arches). Turn and ch 2.

Repeat row 3 until the preferred size. Fasten off and weave in ends
