


# Carly - a striped sweater for kids

## Materials

Colour A: (100) 100 (100) 100 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana  
Colour B: (50) 50 (50) 50 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana  
Colour C: (50) 50 (50) 50 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana  
Colour D: (50) 50 (50) 50 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana  
Colour E: (50) 50 (50) 50 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana  
Colour F: (50) 50 (50) 100 (100) g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana

4 mm and 4,5 mm circular needle, 80 cm  
4 mm and 4,5 mm double-pointed needles (if not using the Magic Loop technique)  
Stitch markers

## Colours

### Version A

Colour A: Colour 956 (Charcoal melange)  
Colour B: Colour 228 (Smoke Blue)  
Colour C: Colour 334 (Light Blush)  
Colour D: Colour 136 (Mustard)  
Colour E: Colour 804 (Merlot melange)  
Colour F: Colour 101 (Natural White)

**Sizes**

(2 years/92 cl) 4 years/104 cl (6 years/116 cl) 8 years/128 cl (10 years/140 cl)

**Measurements**

Body, chest: (26-31) 32-34 (35-36) 37-39 (40-43) cm

Sweater, chest: (64) 69 (76) 82 (87) cm

Sleeve length: (26) 28 (30) 32 (35) cm

Total length: (35) 40 (46) 50 (55) cm

**Gauge**

17 sts and 26 rows in stockinette stitch on 4,5 mm needles = 10 x 10 cm.

**Special abbreviations**

**M1L (Make 1 Left):** Insert the left needle from front to back under the horizontal strand between stitches, lift the strand onto the right needle, then knit it through the back loop.

**M1R (Make 1 Right):** Insert the left needle from back to front under the horizontal strand between stitches, lift the strand onto the right needle, then knit it.

**Directions for knitting**

The sweater is worked from the bottom up. First the body and then the sleeves are worked in the round to the armholes, then the pieces are joined for the yoke which is worked in the round with raglan decreases. Finally, a folded rib neck edge is worked, then folded and sewn in place.

**Body**

Cast on (108) 118 (130) 140 (148) sts on a 4 mm circular needle with colour A. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round. Work (8) 8 (10) 10 (12) rounds in rib (k1, p1).

Change to a 4,5 mm circular needle and work (7) 12 (13) 14 (19) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Change to colour B and work (18) 20 (22) 26 (28) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Change to colour C and work (17) 19 (21) 25 (27) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Bind off for the armholes (colour C) on the next round as follows: Bind off (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) sts, knit (50) 55 (59) 64 (68) sts, bind off (4) 4 (6) 6 (6) sts, knit (50) 55 (59) 64 (68) sts, bind off the last (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) sts of the round.

The work now measures approx. (20) 23 (26) 29 (33) cm.

Let the body rest on the needle while the sleeves are being worked.

**Sleeves**

Cast on (30) 34 (34) 36 (36) sts on a 4 mm circular needle with colour A. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round. Work (8) 8 (10) 12 (12) rounds in rib (k1, p1).

Change to a 4,5 mm circular needle.

Increase (4) 6 (6) 6 (6) sts evenly across the first round to 34 (40) 40 (42) 42 sts.

Now work in alternating stripes of colour F and colour A. Start with colour F.

**Only size (2) 4 years**

Work the stripes as follows:

Work 2 rounds in stockinette stitch.

Increase round: K1, M1L, knit to the last stitch of the round, M1R, k1.

Work (7) 8 (-) - (-) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Work a total of 6 stripes with an increase round for each stripe.

There are now a total of (46) 52 (-) - (-) sts.

**Only size (6) 8 (10) years**

Work the colour F stripe as follows:

Work 2 rounds in stockinette stitch.

Increase round: K1, M1L, knit to the last stitch of the round, M1R, k1.

Work (-) - (8) 9 (10) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Work the colour A stripe as follows:

Work (-) - (2) 2 (2) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Work an increase round.

Work (-) - (4) 4 (5) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Work an increase round.

Work (-) - (3) 4 (4) rounds in stockinette stitch.

Continue in this way, working 1 increase round on stripes with colour A and 2 increase rounds on stripes with colour F until a total of 6 stripes have been worked. There are now (-) - (56) 60 (60) sts.

#### All sizes

Work the last round of the last stripe (colour A) as follows:

Bind off (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) sts, knit (42) 48 (52) 54 (54) sts, bind off the last (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) sts of the round.

Work a second sleeve the same way as the first.

#### **Yoke**

Join the sleeves to the body on the circular needle by placing the sleeve sts over where sts were bound off for the armholes. There are a total of (184) 206 (222) 236 (244) sts on the needle. Place a marker each of the 4 places where sleeves and body meet.

Work the round in stockinette stitch with colour D, working raglan decreases every other round as follows: \*K2tog, knit to 2 sts before marker, ssk\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Change to colour E when a total of (18) 20 (22) 26 (28) rounds have been worked, and (9) 10 (11) 13 (14) decrease rounds.

Continue in colour E with decreases every other round until (14) 16 (18) 16 (16) more rounds have been worked, and (7) 8 (9) 8 (8) decrease round. There are now (56) 62 (62) 68 (68) sts on the needle. End with a round with no decreases.

Change to a 4 mm needle and work 1 round in stockinette stitch. Then work (12) 12 (16) 16 (16) rounds in rib (k1, p1). Bind off in rib.

#### **Finishing**

Sew the little hole under each sleeve.

Fold the neck edge double and sew it to the WS - not too tightly. Weave in all ends.
