# Langelinie - a gorgeous sweater

Langelinie was created as a variation of our very popular design Kastellet. The design is worked in a bulkier yarn and with a wider neckline and gorgeous large, puffed sleeves. The colour was chosen by the designer because it reminds her of new grass and the feeling of spring in the air.

#### **Materials**

450 (500) 550 (600) 650 g Peruvian Highland Wool by Filcolana in colour 279 (Juicy Green)
4,5 mm and 5,5 mm circular needle, 60 and 80 cm
4,5 mm and 5,5 mm double-pointed needles (if not using the magic loop technique)
Markers

Stitch holders

### **Sizes**

XS (S) M (L) XL

#### **Measurements**

Chest, body: 82-89 (90-97) 98-105 (106-113) 114-

121 cm

Chest, sweater: 94 (102) 110 (118) 126 cm Sleeve length: 42 (44) 46 (46) 46 cm Total length: 60 (60) 65 (65) 67 cm

#### Gauge

17 sts and 25 rows in stockinette stitch on a 5,5 mm needle =  $10 \times 10$  cm (after washing).

## **Special abbreviations**

M1: Make 1. Increase one stitch by lifting the chain between sts onto the left meedle and knitting it through the back loop.

tbl: through the back loop

## **Directions for knitting**

The sweater is worked from the top down with a round yoke and a simple eyelet pattern. After the yoke has been knitted, the work is divided into sleeves and bod and each section is finished separately. The Italian cast-on method is used to create the wide neckline. If you prefer a firmer and more close fitting neckline than the one in the photos, cast on using the long-tail cast-on method.

#### Yoke

Cast on 56 (56) 57 (58) 59 sts with a length of scrap yarn on a 4,5 mm circular needle and knit 2 rows. Break the scrap yarn. Change to Peruvian Highland Wool and purl 1 row. Do not turn, but join the work in the round. Purl 2 rounds.

Next round: \*P1, insert the right needle below the chain running between the sts on the first row worked in Peruvian Highland Wool 3 rows below the sts on the needle, and knit this chain \*, repeat from \* to \* until there is 1 stitch left, pick up the last chain 3 rows down and knit it together with the last stitch on the needle. There are now a total of 110 (110) 112 (114) 116 sts on the needle. P1, then place a marker for the beginning of the round. Continue in the round in k1, p1 rib until the rib measures 3 cm. Carefully remove the scrap yarn by cutting it free.

Change to a 5,5 mm needle and continue in the round in pattern:

Round 1-2: Knit.

Round 3: Work as described below.

Rounds 4: Knit.

Round 5: \*Yarn over, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Repeat these 9 rounds throughout, working increases on Rounds 3 as described below:



 $1^{\text{st}}$  round of increases: Knit 2 (2) 4 (6) 8 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 122 (122) 124 (126) 128 m.

 $2^{nd}$  round of increases: Knit 10 (10) 12 (0) 2 sts, \*M1, 8 (8) 8 (9) k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 136 (136) 138 (140) 142 sts on the needle.

 $3^{rd}$  round of increases: Knit 8 (8) 10 (12) 14 sts, \*M1, k8\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 152 (152) 154 (156) 158 sts on the needle.

 $4^{th}$  round of increases Strik 8 (8) 10 (12) 14 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 168 (168) 170 (172) 174 sts on the needle.

 $5^{th}$  round of increases: Knit 6 (6) 8 (10) 12 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 186 (186) 188 (190) 192 sts on the needle.

 $6^{th}$  round of increases: Knit 6 (6) 8 (10) 12 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 206 (206) 208 (210) 212 sts on the needle.

7<sup>th</sup> round of increases: Knit 8 (8) 10 (12) 14 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 228 (228) 230 (232) 234 sts on the needle.

 $8^{th}$  round of increases: Knit 12 (12) 14 (16) 18 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 252 (252) 254 (256) 258 sts on the needle.

## Only size (S) M (L) XL

 $9^{th}$  round of increases: Knit – (0) 2 (4) 6 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (280) 282 (284) 286 sts on the needle.

## Only size M (L) XL

 $10^{th}$  round of increases: Knit - (-) 12 (14) 16 sts, \*M1, k9\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) 312 (314) 316 sts on the needle.

## Only size (L) XL

 $11^{th}$  round of increases: Knit - (-) - (2) 4 sts, \*M1, k13\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) - (338) 340 sts on the needle.

#### Only size XL

 $12^{th}$  round of increases: Knit - (-) - (-) 2 sts, \*M1, k13\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) - (-) 366 sts on the needle.

## All sizes

Knit 2 rounds.

Now divide the work for body and sleeves as follows: Place the next 52 (60) 68 (74) 82 sts on a stitch holder (right sleeve), cast on 6 new sts in extension of the sts on the needle for the underarm, knit 74 (80) 88 (95) 101 sts (front), place the next 52 (60) 68 (74) 82 sts on a stitch holder (right sleeve), cast on 6

new sts in extension of the sts on the needle for the underarm, knit 74 (80) 88 (95) 101 sts (back).

## **Body**

Knit 1 round.

Next round: \*Yarn over, k2tog \*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

There are now 160 (172) 188 (202) 214 sts on the needle.

Continue in the round in stockinette stitch until the work measures 55 (55) 60 (60) 62 cm.

Change to a 4,5 mm needle. Work 5 cm og k1, p1 rib. Bind off loosely in rib.

#### **Sleeves**

Pick up and knit 5 sts from the RS with a 5,5 mm needle, starting in the centre of the newly cast-on sts at the underarm, knit across the resting sleeve sts, then pick up and knit another 5 sts along the underarm sts on the body (Note: 2 extra sts are picked up before and after the 6 sts that were cast on on the body to close the little holes that otherwise might be in the work. There are now a total of 62 (70) 78 (84) 92 sts on the needle.

Continue in pattern until a total of 20 (21) 22 (22) 22 rows of eyelets have been worked.

End with a knit round.

Change to a 4,5 mm needle.

#### Only size XS (S)

Next round: K1, p1, \*k2tog, p2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now 32 (36) - (-) - sts on the needle.

## Only size M (L)

Next round: \*Knit - (-) 11 (19) - sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) 72 (80) - sts on the needle.

Next round: \*K2tog, p2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) 36 (40) - sts on the needle.

## Only size XL

Next round: K4, \*k5 k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to the last 4 sts, k4. There are now - (-) - (-) 80 sts on the needle.

Next round: \*K2tog, p2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round. There are now - (-) - (-) 40 sts on the needle.

## All sizes

Work 2 cm of k1, p1 rib. Bind off in rib.

## **Finishing**

Weave in the ends. Wash the top according to the instructions on the yarn. Lay it on a flat surface to dry.
