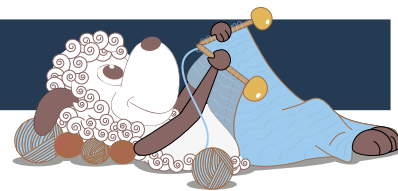


Elisabeth - a beautiful square shawl

A beautiful square shawl knit in pure lambs wool.

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English translation: Signe Strømgaard

Materials

300 g of New Zealand Lammeuld by Filcolana
4 mm double-pointed needles
4 mm circular needle, 60 cm, 80 cm, and 100 cm long

Measurements

110 cm x 110 cm.

Gauge

20 sts and 36 rows in stockinette stitch = 10 x 10cm.

The shawl

cast on 8 sts and distribute them evenly over 4 double-pointed needles. Join in the round.

Round 1: *Knit 1, yarn over, knit 1*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 2: *Knit 1, yarn over, knit 1, yarn over, knit 1*. Repeat from * to * to end of round.

Round 2 is also the first row of the chart, which shows 1/4 of the shawl. Placing a stitch marker at each corner can help make the work easier.

Work the chart from row 1 to 151. All even numbered rows (not shown in the chart) are knit.
Then work row 33 to 79 once. Then work the little chart at the top of the page.










Rows A to E of the chart are also only showing pattern rows. Between each of these rows a "resting" row is worked where knit stitches are knit and purl stitches are purled.
Finish each tip separately according to the chart. Knit all rows.

Weave in the ends, gently wash and rinse the shawl in lukewarm water. Block it to shape and leave it to dry completely.



Chart Key

The thicker lines in the chart mark the pattern repeat. The numbers in the chart tell you how many stitches are to be worked. First work row 1 to 151 of the chart, then work row 33 to 79. There are 812 sts on the needle at the end. Then work the little chart at the top, starting at row A. Remember to work the a resting row between each of the charted rows.

-  Knit from the RS, purl from the WS.
-  Yarn over
-  K2tog through the back loops
-  K2tog
-  K3tog (slip 1, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over)
-  Garter stitch: Knit all rows
-  Stitch count.
-  Purl on the RS.
-  No stitch
