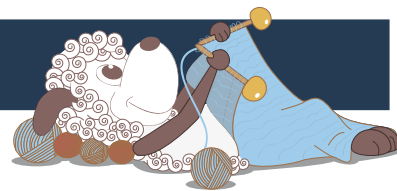


# Nytorv - a rib hat

A lovely, warm hat designed with a twist of luxury in the form of the Tilia mohair yarn, which is held together with Peruvian Highland Wool while knitting the crown of the hat.

## Materials

Color A: 100 g Peruvian Highland Wool fra Filcolana i farve 954 (Light Grey)

Color B: 25 g Tilia fra Ficolana i farve 331 (Steel)

Circular needle 4 og 6 mm, 40 cm

## Measurements

Fits head circumference: 52 (57) cm

## Gauge, ribbed rim

22 sts and 10 rows in pattern on 4 mm needles = 10 x 4 cm.

## Directions for knitting

The hat is worked from the bottom up and in the round on a short circular needle.

## Hue

Cast on 85 (95) sts on a 4 mm circular needle with color A. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round.

**Work 4 cm of rib:** \*K3 through the back loop, p2\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Change to a 6 mm circular needle and join color B to be worked held together with color A.

Next round: \*P3, k2 through the back loop\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Continue as established until the work measures 27 cm.

**Next round:** \*P1, p2tog, k2tog\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Break the yarn and thread the end through the remaining sts on the needle. Pull tight and weave in the ends.

Gently rinse the work and put it through a (dry) spin cycle in the washing machine. Lay it flat to dry.
