Thorup - a feminine colorwork cape

Design: Janne Højfeldt

Short poncho or cape knitted in Pernilla by Filcolana. The poncho can be worn over a t-shirt and a jacket. The shorter length means the arms have full mobility, making it simple to wear while biking, driving of sitting at the keyboard.

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Materials

Pernilla by Filcolana:

Main color:

200 (250) 250 (300) 300 (350) g in color 978 (Oatmeal)

Pattern colors:

50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g in color 975 (Dark Chocolate)

50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g in color 823 (Juniper) 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g in color 820 (Isabella)

3 mm circular needle, 40 cm

3,5 mm circular needle, 40 and 80 cm

1 stitch markers

Sizes

XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL)

Measurements

Circumference at hem: 126 (134) 142 (150) 158 (167)

Length at center (all sizes): 39 cm (the poncho is

easily extended)

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Gauge

24 sts and 30 rows in stranded pattern on a 3,5 mm needle = 10×10 cm

Directions for knitting

The poncho is worked from the top down is the round in the charted patterns. The hem is folded and sewn to the WS. At the end sts are picked up at the neck edge and the turtle neck is worked.

Yoke

Cast on 110 (120) 120 (130) 130 (130) sts on a 40 cm long 3,5 mm circular needle with the main color. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round - which is the side of the work.

Work chart 1 and increase at the same time as follows: The increases are worked as yarn overs that are then knit through the back loop on the next round.

Round 2: Increase 20 sts (all sizes) evenly across round. There are now 130 (140) 140 (150) 150 (150) sts.

Round 4: Increase 20 sts (all sizes) evenly across round.

There are now 150 (160) 160 (170) 170 (170) sts.

Round 6: Increase 20 sts (all sizes) evenly across round. There are now 170 (180) 180 (190) 190 (190) sts.

Round 11: Increase 20 sts evenly across round. There are now 190 (200) 200 (210) 210 (210) sts.

Round 13: Increase 10 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) sts evenly across round. There are now: 200 (220) 220 (230) 230 (230) sts.

Round 20: Increase 10 (10) 20 (20) 20 (20) sts evenly across round. There are now: 210 (230) 240 (250) 250 (250) sts.

Round 22: Increase 10 (10) 10 (20) 20 (20) sts evenly across round. There are now: 220 (240) 250 (270) 270 (270) sts.

Round 27: Increase 10 (10) 10 (10) 20 (20) sts evenly across round. There are now: 230 (250) 260 (280) 290 (290) sts.

Round 29: Increase 10 (10) 10 (10) 10 (20) sts evenly across round. There are now: 240 (260) 270 (290) 300 (310) sts.

Round 38: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round. There are now: 250 (270) 280 (300) 310 (320) sts.

Round 40: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round.

There are now: 260 (280) 290 (310) 320 (330) sts. Round 45: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round.

There are now: 270 (290) 300 (320) 330 (340) sts.

Round 47: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round.

There are now: 280 (300) 310 (330) 340 (350) sts. Round 56: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round.

There are now: 290 (310) 320 (340) 350 (360) sts.

Round 58: Increase 10 sts (all sizes) evenly across round. There are now: 300 (320) 330 (350) 360 (370) sts.

Round 63: Tag 0 (0) 10 (10) 10 (10) sts evenly across round. There are now: 300 (320) 340 (360) 370 (380)

Round 65: Tag 0 (0) 0 (0) 10 (10) sts evenly across round. There are now: 300 (320) 340 (360) 380 (390) sts.

Round 74: Tag 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (10) sts evenly across round.

Chart 1


Knit all sts. Chart is read from right to left on all rounds. Repeat pattern across entire round.

Main color 978

Color 820

Color 975

Color 823



Thorup

There are now: 300 (320) 340 (360) 380 (400) sts. Continue straight in chart 1, until all 100 rounds have been worked.

Work chart 2 = 16 round.

Purl 1 round.

Knit 19 rounds in the main color. Bind off.

Turtle neck

Pick up and knit 112 (120) 120 (132) 132 (132) sts from the RS with a 40 cm long 3 mm circular needle and the main color along the neck edge. Join in the round and place a marker for the beginning of the round - the side of the work. Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 16 cm. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing

Weave in the ends. Fold the hem along the purled round and sew the bind-off edge to the WS of the poncho. The turtle neck can also, optionally, be folded double and sewn down.
