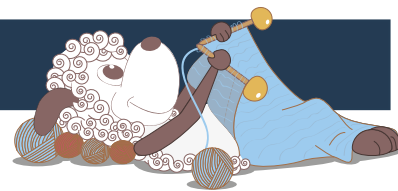


Aviaja - a big, cozy shawl

A big, cozy shawl to cuddle up in.

Materials

600 g of Genuine Greenland Wool by Filcolana in color 207 (petrol)

7 mm circular needle, 100 cm long

Marker or length of scrap yarn

Size

One size:

Neck to mid back: approx. 100 cm

Wing span: approx. 230 cm

Gauge

12 sts and 26 rows (13 garter ridges) in garter stitch on a 7 mm needle = 10 x 10 cm.

Directions for knitting

The shawl is worked from the center out in garter ridges (ie. knit on all rows). Change yarns by split splicing the ends together for the most even transitions and to avoid having to weave in the ends when you're done knitting.

The shawl

Cast on 400 sts.

Row 1: Knit all sts. Mark the center of the shawl (after 200 sts) using a length of scrap yarn or a stitch



marker.

Row A: K3, k2tog twice, knit to the center marker, slip marker, k2tog, knit to end of row.
Repeat row A until there are 128 sts left on either side of the center marker (and you have knit 24 garter ridges).

Row B: K3, k2tog once, knit to the center marker, slip marker, k2tog, knit to end of row.
Repeat row B until there are 4 sts left on either side of the center marker
Bind off.
Sew the slit (bind-off edge) together. Weave in all ends.
