Josefine - a triangular shawl

A lovely triangular shawl knit in hand dyed alpaca. The shawl is knit from the center of the neck out.

Materials

100 g of Indiecita by Filcolana, solid color 100 g Indiecita by Filcolana, hand dyed color 4 mm circular needle

Measurements

approx. 63 x 140 cm.

Gauge

20 sts and 36 rows in pattern = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$.

The shawl is knit from the center of the neck out, and is worked in alternating 2 row stripes of stockinette stitch in the hand dyed colorway (color B) and garter stitch in the solid colorway (color A).

Shown models

Green version: solid color: 146, hand dyed color: 507 Red version: solid color: 245, hand dyed color: 505

Shawl

Cast on 3 sts using color A.

Row 1 (WS - color A): K3.

Row 2 (color B): K1, M1, k, M1, k1.

Row 3 (color B): Purl.

Row 4 (color A): K1, M1, k1, M1, k1, M1, k1, M1, k1.

Row 5 (color A): Knit.

Row 6 (color B): K3, M1, k1, M1, k1 (center stitch - place a marker thread around this stitch), M1, k1, M1, k3.

Row 7 (color B): Purl.

Row 8 (color A): k3, M1, k3, M1, k1, M1, k3, M1, k3.

Row 9 (color A): Knit.

Continue as established working 2 row stripes of each color while increasing every other row (RS): Increase one st 3 sts from either edges and one on either side of the center stitch.

Start working the edging in color B when there is a total of 293 sts on the needle, ie. when there are 146 sts on either side of the center stitch. End on a RS row.

Row 1 (WS): K1, *p1, k5*, repeat from * to * until 1 st before the center stitch, p1, k1 (center stitch), repeat from * to * until the last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2: k1, M1, k1, M1, *k5, M1, k1, M1*, repeat from * to * to the center stitch, k1, M1, k1, M1, repeat from * to * to the final stitch, k1.

Row 3: k1, p3, *k5, p3*, repeat from * to * until to

the center stitch, k1, p3, repeat from * to * to the final stitch, k1.

Row 4: k1, M1, k3, M1, *k5, M1, k3, M1*, repeat from * to * to the center stitch, k1, M1, k3, M1, repeat from * to * to the final stitch, k1.

Row 5: k1, p5, *k5, 5p*, repeat from * to * to the center stitch, k1, p5, repeat from * to * to the final stitch, k1.

Continue the increases every other row (RS) on both sides of the stockinette stitches, with garter stitch in between, until there are has 11 stockinette stitches in the pattern repeat. Work another 4 rows straight in pattern. Change to color A and work another 2 rows in pattern. Bind off knit-wise on a RS row.

Finishing

Gently rinse the shawl and lay it flat to dry.
