


Tiliana - a large, wonderful shawl

Tiliana is generously sized triangle-shaped shawl knit with two strands held together in a combination of stockinette stitch and an easy-to memorize lace pattern.

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Materials

Indiecita by Filcolana: 200 g

Tilia by Filcolana: 75 g

- one strand of each yarn is held together throughout.

5 mm (100 cm) circular needle

4 stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Beige version (top right photo)

Indiecita fv. 979 (Pebbles)

Tilia fv. 336 (Latte)

Rødbrun version (bottom right photo)

Indiecita fv. 827 (Dijon melange)

Tilia fv. 352 (Red Squirrel)

Grøn version (centre of photo below)

Indiecita fv. 146 (Deep Sea)

Tilia fv. 124 (Reseda)

Sizes

One size

Measurements

Length (top edge): 180 cm

depth (center): 90 cm

Gauge

14 sts and 24 rows in stockinette stitch after blocking
= 10 x 10 cm.



Special abbreviations

M1L: from the front, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle and knit through the back loop;

M1R: from the back, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle and knit through the front loop;

S1-k2tog-pss0: slip one stitch knitwise, then knit 2 stitches together and pass the slipped stitch over
w&t - wrap and turn: On a knit row, slip next st pur-
lwise with yarn in back onto right-hand needle, bring
yarn to front of work, return slipped st to left-hand
needle, bring yarn to back of work, and then turn
work. On a purl row, slip next st purlwise with yarn
in front onto right-hand needle, bring yarn to back of
work, return slipped st to left-hand needle, bring yarn
to front of work, and then turn work;

SRE - short row edge: k8, w&t, k7, w&t, k6, w&t, k5,
w&t, k4, w&t, k3, w&t, k2, w&t, k1, w&t.

Note: You don't have to pick up wraps and work them together with wrapped stitches as bumps of the wraps will blend in with garter stitch.

Directions for knitting

This shawl is knit from the top to the bottom.

Set up section

With two strands of yarn held together, cast on 3 sts and knit 7 rows.

At the end of Row 7 do not turn work, but rotate piece 90 degrees clockwise and pick up and knit 3 sts along the edge. You should pick up one st in each garter st ridge.

Rotate piece 90 degrees clockwise and pick up and knit 3 sts along cast on edge. You should pick up 1 st in each cast on st. [9 sts]. Turn work and work k3, k3, k3.

Set up Row 1 (RS): K3, pm, yo, k1, M1R, pm, k1, pm, M1L, k1, yo, pm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Set up Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, p to last m, sm, k3.

Section 1 – stockinette stitch pattern

Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, yo, knit to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm,



M1L, knit to next m, yo, sm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, purl to last m, sm, k3.

Repeat last two rows until there are 257 sts on the needles.

Next Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, yo, knit to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm, M1L, knit to next m, yo, sm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Next Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, knit to m, sm, k3.

Repeat last two rows one more time. [265 sts on the needles]

Section 2 – lace pattern


Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, yo, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm, M1L, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern to last m, yo, sm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches as they face you (through the back loop if necessary) to last m, sm, k3.

Row 3: K3, sm, yo, work next row of Lace Pattern to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm, M1L, work next row of Lace Pattern to last m, yo, sm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Row 4: As Row 2.

Continue in established pattern, working appropriate Rows of Lace Pattern. [total of 64 sts increased; 329 sts on the needles]

— pattern repeat

Row 1: K1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k3, * s1-k2tog-psso, k3; repeat from * to last 10 sts, s1-k2tog-psso, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k1.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches as they face you (through the back loop if necessary).

Row 3: K3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k2, * s1-k2tog-psso, k2; repeat from * to last 11 sts, s1-k2tog-psso, k2, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3.

Row 5: K5, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1, * s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k5, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1; repeat from * to last 12 sts, s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3.

Row 7: K7, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, * s1-k2tog-psso, k1tbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k7, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl; repeat from * to last 13 sts, s1-k2tog-psso, k1tbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k7.

Row 9: Ktbl, k3, k2tog, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, * k1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k3, s1-k2tog-psso, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo; repeat from * to last 13 sts, k1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k3, s1-k2tog-psso, k2, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k1; repeat from * to last 14 sts, k2, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k2, s1-k2tog-psso, k2, ktbl, yo, ktbl, k1; repeat from * to last 14 sts, s1-k2tog-psso, k2, ktbl, yo, ktbl.

Row 13: K1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1, s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k2, * k3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1, s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k2; repeat from * to last 15 sts, k3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1, s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k1.

Row 15: K3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, s1-k2tog-psso, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3, * k4, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, s1-k2tog-psso, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3; repeat from * to end.

Row 17: K2tog, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3, * s1-k2tog-psso, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, ssk.

Row 19: K1, k2tog, k2, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k2, * s1-k2tog-psso, k2, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k3, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k2; repeat from * to last 3 sts, ssk, k1.

Row 21: Ktbl, k1, k2tog, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k5, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k2, * s1-k2tog-psso, k1, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k5, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k1; repeat from * to last 4 sts, ssk, k1, ktbl.

Row 23: K2tog, yo, ktbl, k2tog, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k7, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, * s1-k2tog-psso, k1tbl, p1, ktbl, yo, k7, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl; repeat from * to last 5 sts, ssk, k1tbl, yo, ssk.

Row 25: K2tog, p1, ktbl, yo, * k1, yo, ktbl, p1, ktbl, k3, s1-k2tog-psso, k3, ktbl, p1, ktbl, yo;

Section 3 - border

Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, yo, knit to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm, M1L, knit to last m, yo, sm, k3. [4 sts increased]

Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, knit to last m, sm, k3.

Repeat last two rows one more time. [337 sts on the needles]

Row 5: K3, rm, yo, k6, * SRE, k12; repeat from * to 15 sts before m, SRE, k to m, M1R, sm, k1, sm, M1L, k6, * SRE, k12; repeat from * to 15 sts before last m, SRE, k to m, yo, rm, k3.

Finishing

Cast off all sts knitwise. Weave in all ends and block to measurements.

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repeat from * to last 5 sts, k1, yo, k1tbl, p1, ssk.

Row 27: K2tog, p1, k1tbl, yo, k1, * k2, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k2, s1-k2tog-pssو, k2, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k1; repeat from * to last 6 sts, k2, yo, k1tbl, p1, ssk.

Row 29: K2tog, p1, k1tbl, yo, k2, * k3, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, k1, s1-k2tog-pssو, k1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k2; repeat from * to last 7 sts, k3, yo, k1tbl, p1, ssk.

Row 31: K2tog, p1, k1tbl, yo, k3, * k4, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, s1-k2tog-pssو, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, k3; repeat from * to 8 sts, k4, yo, k1tbl, p1, ssk.
