# Rosmarin - a lovely colorwork hat

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There really is nothing better than colorwork knitting in a gorgeous yarn like Pernilla, which is so perfectly suited for it. The knitting is a pure pleasure and the result is so even and lovely.

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#### **Materials**

Color A: 20-25 g Pernilla by Filcolana in color 808 (Aqua Mist (melange))

Color B: 15-20 g Pernilla by Filcolana in color 957

(Very Light Grey (melange))
3 and 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm

# **Sizes**

Small child (large child/small adult) large adult

#### **Measurements**

Head circumference: 45-50 (50-55) 55-60 cm

Height: 18 (20) 22 cm

# Gauge

23 sts and 28 rows in stockinette stitch on 3,5 mm needles =  $10 \times 10$  cm.

# Special abbreviations

<u>M1</u>: Make 1. Increase one stitch by lifting the chain between sts onto the left needle and knitting it through the back loop.

# **Directions for knitting**

The hat is worked from the bottom up. The pattern and the decreases for the crown are both written and charted. A pompom can be added at the end if desired (see image at bottom).

#### Hat

Cast on 90 (100) 108 sts on a 3 mm circular needle and join in the round.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing until hat measures 2,5 cm. Change to 4 mm circular needle.

# Size small child and large adult

Next round: \*M1, k9\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

## Size large child/small adult

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Next round: K1, \*M1, k9\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

## All sizes

There are now 100 (110) 120 sts on the needle. Work 2 rounds of stockinette stitch.

<u>Size large child/small adult only</u>: Work row 5-8 of Pattern A.





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All sizes: Work all of the rows of Pattern A (either charted or written) a total of 3 (3) 4 times.

Then work Pattern B with decreases (either charted or written).

There are now 10 (11) 12 sts on the needle.

Break the yarn. Pull the color A end through the remaining sts on the needle. Weave in the ends.

## Pattern A

**Round 1:** K3 with color A, \*k4 with color B, k6 with color A\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 7 sts. End with k4 with color B, k3 with color A.

**Round 2:** K1 with color A, \*k3 with color B, k2 with color A\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 5 sts. End with k3 with color B, k1 with color A.

Round 3: Work as Round 2.

**Round 4:** K2 with color B, \*k6 with color A, k4 with color B\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 8 sts. End with k6 with color A, k2 with color B.

**Round 5:** Work as Round 4. omg. **Rounds 6 and 7:** Work as Round 2.

Round 8: Work as Round 1.

#### Pattern B - with decreases

**Round 1:** K3 with color A, \*k4 with color B, k6 with color A\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 7 sts. End with k4 with color B, k3 with color A.

**Round 2:** K1 with color A, \*k3 with color B, k2 with color A\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 5 sts. End with k3 with color B, k1 with color A.

Round 3: Work as Round 2.

**Round 4:** K2 with color B, \*k6 with color A, k4 with color B\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 8 sts. End with k6 with color A, k2 with color B.

Round 5: Work as Round 4.

**Round 6:** K4 with color B, \*k2 with color A, 8 r med color B\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the last 8 sts. End with k2 with color A, k4 with color B.

**Round 7:** \*Ssk, k2 with color B, k2 with color A, k2 with color B, k2tog\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Break color A. Continue in color B.

Round 8 and 9: Knit to end of round.

**Round 10:** \*Ssk, k4, k2tog\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Round 11 and 12: Knit to end of round.


**Round 13:** \*Ssk, k2, k2tog\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Round 14 and 15: Knit to end of round.

**Round 16:** \*Ssk, k2tog\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

Round 17: Knit to end of round.

Round 18: K2tog to end of round.



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
